## SAMPLE BEQUEST LANGUAGE

### Directing your support to the University of Hawai'i

This sample language may be helpful as you work with your attorney to include a gift to the University of Hawai'i Foundation for the benefit of UH in your estate plan.

#### UNRESTRICTED BEQUESTS

##### ***Bequest of a Specific Dollar Amount:***

I hereby give, devise and bequeath \_\_\_\_\_ and No/100 dollars (\$DOLLARS) to the University of Hawai'i Foundation, a nonprofit organization located at 1314 S. King St., Suite B, Honolulu, HI, 96814, Federal Tax ID #99-0085260, for the University of Hawai'i Foundation's general use and purpose.

##### ***Bequest of a Percent of the Estate:***

I hereby give, devise and bequeath \_\_\_\_ percent ( \_\_ %) of the remainder and residue of property owned at my death, whether real or personal and wherever located, to the University of Hawai'i Foundation, a nonprofit organization located at 1314 S. King St., Suite B, Honolulu, HI, 96814, Federal Tax ID #99-0085260, for the University of Hawai'i Foundation's general use and purpose.

#### RESTRICTED BEQUESTS

##### ***To make your bequest restricted, the language should read\*:***
